SUPPLEMENT TO RULES and FINALS QUALIFICATIONS.

A Player must play 3 junior games to qualify for finals.

- a. Where a club has more than one team in an age group regardless of division, once a player has played more than 8 Saturdays/Friday nights, they cannot change divisions or teams, except where a club has 2 teams in the same age group playing finals on the same day they can only have a maximum of 3 changes between the sides.
- b. Players are able to move up a division even if they have played more than 8 Saturdays, but they cannot move down, except for the exception above.

POINTS SYSTEM

Under 17's and Under 15's as Seniors

Under 13's and Under 11's – 6 Points WIN

-3 Points TIE each

-3 Points WASH OUT each

TIE BREAKER – 1. Total runs scored divided by wickets lost.

IF REQUIRED – 2. Total wickets taken divided by runs scored against.

OVERAGE PERMITS RESTRICTIONS for Under 13 Players.

Once the player has batted, they cannot return retired or not.

They are restricted to a maximum of 3 overs per match.

They must not bat again in a match until all players in the team have had the opportunity to bat whether this takes 1, 2, or 3 games.
